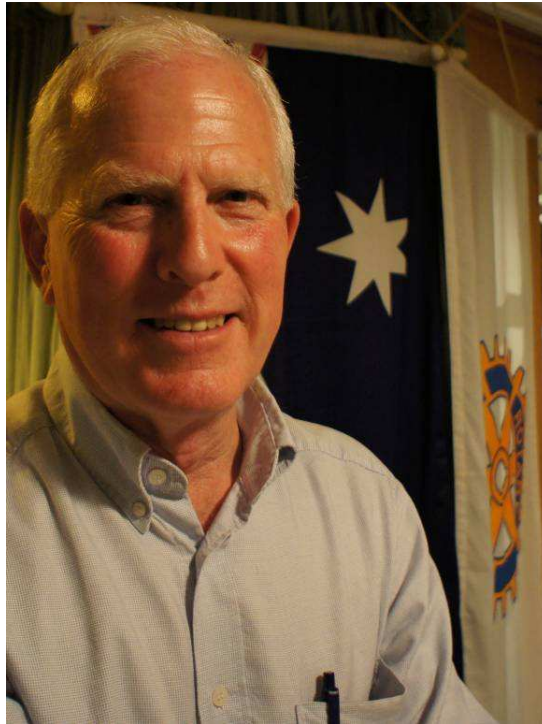

It was great to see many club members with their partners and visiting Rotarians as well as Alan's wife Rosemary.

In the 50 years that Alan has been involved with the Vet business a lot has changed. He talked of starting as a 'kennel man' when he was 12 years old, mucking out horse stables etc.

The concept of Vets working on small animals came from the demise of the horse and buggy. Now many local practices deal with only small animals even in country areas.

From one or two female vets, we now have 85% and few want to service large animals causing some concern.

Alan went on to also talk about the cross over in medicines and the future trends in the medical profession that will affect everyone.

John Messner presented Alan with a thankyou card and expressed our gratitude for his insightful talk.

I'm glad I'm a Rotarian and that you are one too.

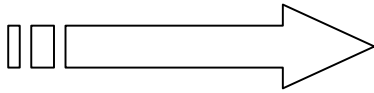

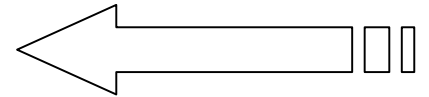

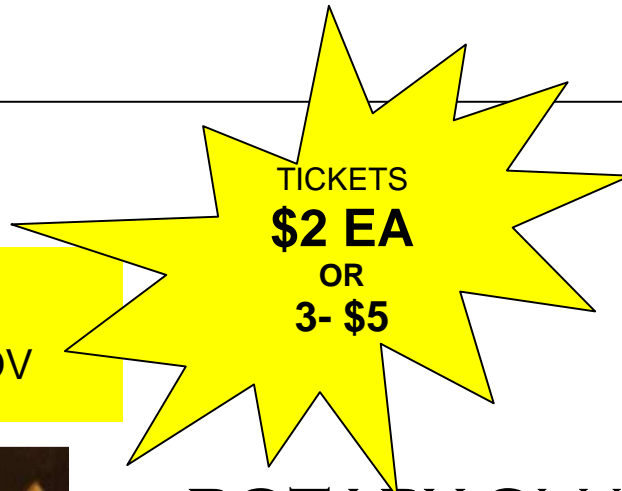
