DG Bill Seelis writes to inform us that “the result of the ballot has decided that District 9710 will endorse the ShelterBox program as a multi-district project, and I wish to thank all of the Clubs that have participated to bring about this result, and I will inform ShelterBox in Australia accordingly.”

“What this means is that the project will not be at any cost to the Clubs or Districts. For the record, since starting the revamped SBA in July, some \$750K has been donated by individuals and Rotary Clubs, meaning we anticipate an income for the 12 months in excess of \$2 million by Australians including Zone 8 Rotary clubs. That represents a continuation of the support that has been achieved in the past.”

“All Zone 8 Rotarians have an opportunity to participate – by way of donations and promotion. Also some Zone 8 Rotarians have trained and been deployed as SRT (ShelterBox Response Team) members and several are currently deployed to disaster events. Two have recently gone out from Australia – one to Indonesia and another to Philippines.”
