Welcome to a chilly week which we hope will turn into a fine and mild weekend and a good one for the Town, the Oyster Festival Committee and us.

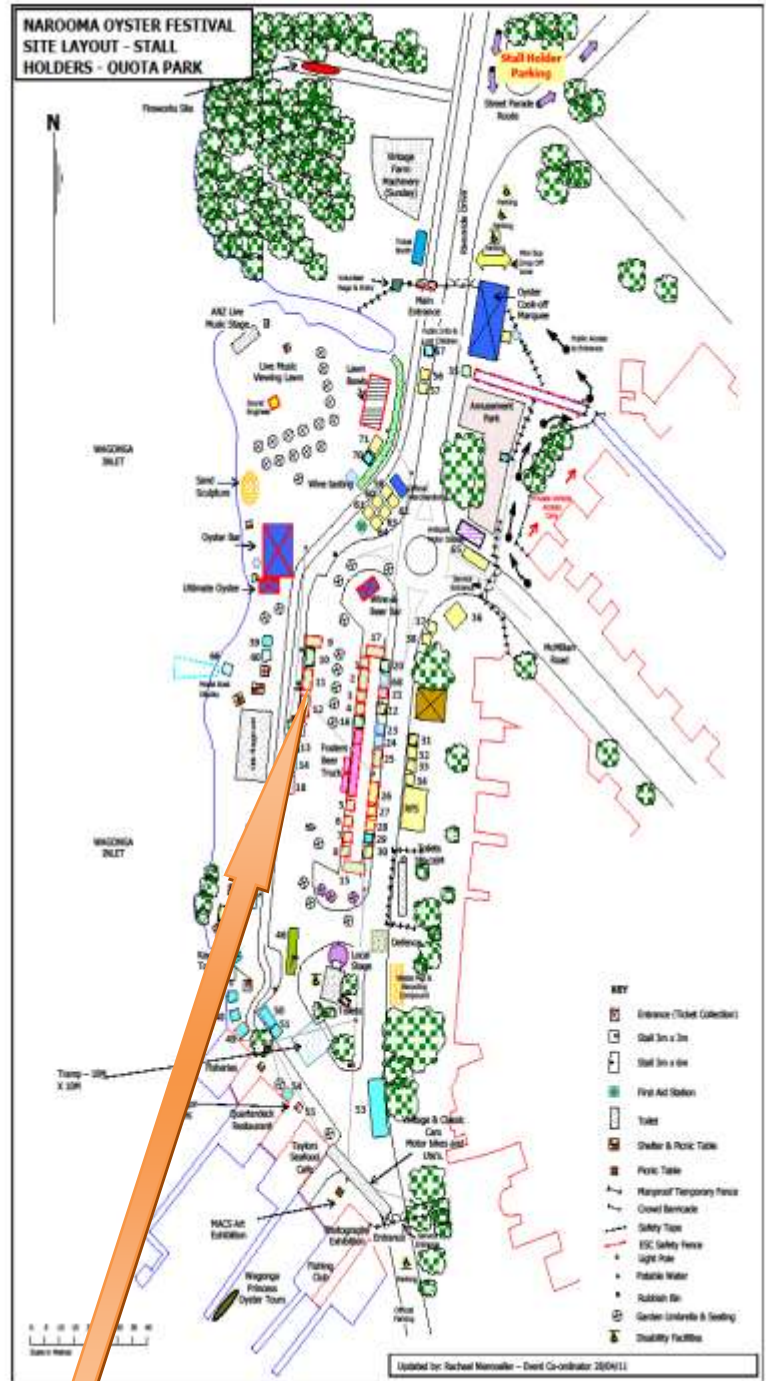
My thanks for the helpers on Saturday, a great job done and also to all who have been cleaning the van after each Market. This made Saturday a lot easier.
