Rotary Club of Bega - 60th Birthday celebration on 21 Aug 2014

Bega RC celebrated the 60th anniversary of their first Charter dinner which took place on 21/8/1954 at the CWA with dinner costing 8/6d. It was a fun night for Charmaine, Jack and I. Many toasts were made recalling the history of Rotary International and various milestones of the Club. The Rotary Clubs of Cooma and Queabeyan sponsored the Bega Club who in turn later sponsored 3 other Clubs, Narooma RC in 1958, then Merimbula RC 1969 and Eden RC 1971. Some major Bega Rotary projects over time included: sponsoring nurses from PNG & Malaysia to train at Bega hospital, fundraising for the Regional mobile Blood Bank, birth to Kindergarten Reading Program, and the Bega Book Fair which Rotary runs twice a year, in Jan & July. This year was a huge success with 25,000 books sold and \$13,000 raised.
