Heide Smith's talk 30 October 2014 – A Photographer's Story

What a delightful and privileged evening we all enjoyed with our guest speaker Heide Smith, professional photographer extraordinaire! Heide's life has been rich and varied. Growing up in Germany in the small town of Hameln (*origin of the Pied Piper story*), an apprenticeship in photography then lead to advertising and photojournalism, eventually specialising in portraits, for which she is now quite famous. Then she met Brian, a dashing British Army Officer, married, move to England and eventually they migrated to Australia in 1971. Canberra beckoned and Heide, Brian and children settled in Braddon. Then a seachange, moving to Narooma and aren't we so lucky to have them in our midst!



Heide's highly acclaimed photographs soon impacted on Canberra society and beyond. A 'Heide Smith Studio' was established in Fyshwick in 1979 employing more photographers and staff to meet the demands of their growing business, so ably managed by Brian's public relations skills.

We were treated to a visual feast of her images which have received so many awards and accolades. Some examples of her portraits over time which capture the essence and the personality included Women in Sheets,
