### Angie's Angle..... Ian Langworthy's talk 6 November 2014 – Active Endeavours

Ian Langworthy, CEO, Active Endeavours truly inspired us. An engaging man of many skills & talents, teacher, boat builder and so much more. Active Endeavour's motto is building boats; building futures which encompasses beautifully Ian's vision to deliver marine related programs to help disadvantaged youth in our area. The aim is to engage them to change course, get on board with Ian building boats, learning new skills and thereby hoisting their sails to bright, new, empowering horizons.



Currently Ian is teaching 7 boys & girls at Narooma High to build a 6 m plywood boat. These students had difficulty relating to mainstream maths and other issues which may have influenced them to leave school early. So.. the idea was born how to help them by looking outside the square. Ian is keen on experiential learning, thus providing our youth especially with life and employment skills. Building boats from scratch is a great way to learn mathematical skills and enjoy the journey interacting within the group. Today, Narooma High has embraced this test case offered by Active Endeavours, whose very name spells out its mission. Active Endeavours is now a registered Charity and Ian is very busy applying for grants and promoting his business. Many organisations are showing interest in Ian's endeavours. Eurobodalla and Queanbeyan Shire Councils as well as the Department of Juvenile Justice are keen to expand the philosophy into the wider community. Ian's plans include boat building on a big scale. These include rowing boats, sailing boats, sea kayaks, skiffs, paddles & oars etc which can be built by Active Endeavours on commission once they have premises and to help cover costs as they expand. Down the track he plans to make fun cardboard boats as well ... and who knows, our Club may just collaborate with him on some future aquatic event here.
