Angie's Angle.....

John Rungen's talk 27 November 2014 – The Rotary Foundation

John Rungen, our Foundation Director, gave us a presentation on the Rotary Foundation from a recent District Grants & Foundation seminar he attended in Canberra.

Here are a few notes:

The Rotary Foundation begun in 1917 by Arch Klumph, 6th international president of Rotary who convinced Rotarians of the need for an endowment for 'doing good in the world'.

The mission of The Rotary Foundation (TRF) is to enable Rotarians to achieve world understanding, goodwill and peace through the improvement of health, the support of education and the alleviation of poverty. The Foundation has the ability to review, organise and implement international programs of major humane benefit at minimal administrative cost.

Foundation's 4 goals:

eradicate Polio

build the Foundation

launch Grant models

engage innovative partnerships & projects

India – 5 years ago India was home to 50% of the world's polio cases.

Because of Rotary, India is now polio free! South East Asia is polio free.

The aim is to eradicate it totally by 2018. This takes huge effort and costs.

\$US5.51 billion has been deemed needed by Rotary for the strategic plan.

To make it work Rotary is in partnership with the Bill & Melinda Gates

Foundation who have pledged to double the \$35m Rotary raises each year

for this project. A huge task - esp. on the ground efforts to eliminate polio

in the last 3 endemic countries – Nigeria, Afghanistan & Pakistan.

Rotary can achieve the impossible!! – it is through donations to the Rotary Foundation (tax deductible) that our financial targets can be achieved.
