Angie's Angle.....

Charmaine White's talk 5 February 2015 - Back to the Roots in the Kimberley

We all enjoyed Charmaine's presentation on the week she spent in the Kimberley June last year, volunteering her dental skills together with Sharon White, her dental assistant. Both had wonderful stories to tell about joining with the Kimberley Dental Team, sponsored by businesses Dental Partners, Lottery West and McCusker Financial Trust to provide much needed dental care to isolated, low socio indigenous communities between Halls Creek and Broome.

John Owen, an orthodontist from Perth, heads the team of 4 dentists, a labour of love which he and his wife have run now for many years. Things were not simple and had to be highly organised to deal with the unique, uncertain conditions in the region. For example, the specially equipped caravan had to navigate over red dirt (*everywhere*), corrugated, rough roads and remain intact – quite an achievement. Also, once the equipment was set up and running, catering to the needs of young and old in the community – they hoped that the power would stay connected for the duration of treatment!

Alleviating pain by doing extractions was the bulk of the work. Delighted smiles were enough reward often after very long days. Preventative dentistry and health education was practised. Toothbrushes and pamphlets were handed out to take home. The children loved that attention in particular.

Charmaine has previously volunteered her dental services in Kenya, Thailand, Nepal and Jamaica. She mentioned joining with the Bega Rotary team around July this year going to East Timor. Truly 'Service above Self'.
