Michael, our lovable Irishman and Marathon Man extraordinaire, entertained and informed us last night. Just back from running the Buller Gorge half marathon (21.1 kms!) in Westport, NZ to raise money & awareness for Rangi School, Homa Bay District, Kenya, Africa. Out of 880 participants, Michael came 368 in fine time – what a feat! He is passionate about supporting this Primary School and delighted that he raised \$2,500 on this occasion, enough to build half a classroom!

Friends of Rangi (FOR), a Non Government Organisation (NGO), was set up in Tamworth where Michael hailed from, by Michael and Jennifer Hawthorne, to increase access to quality education and improve living standards of the vulnerable in rural Kenya. Michael spoke about the St Jennifer Hawthorne Samber Quality Primary School which was set up as a private alternative to the very poorly run/funded local Government schools – often 80 to 120 children in a classroom!

This boarding school, which has only been going for about 5 years, catering to mainly orphans whose parents died of HIV, now proudly boasts about 300 students from
