Gary Dunbar's talk about PCYC (Police Citizens Youth Club)

Gary has recently taken on the role of Far South Coast Manager for PCYC and gave an interesting presentation last night on the history of PCYC, it's link with Rotary and vision for its future locally.

PCYC is celebrating 78 years since its inception in Sydney back in 1937. Back then William MacKay, Police Commissioner collaborated with Rotary to start what was called Police Boys Citizenship Clubs. The need was great post the Depression to harness the energies of underprivileged boys in Sydney aged 10 to 16 as a preventative solution to crime. Mentoring the boys and getting them engaged in sports like boxing and wrestling proved very popular and the Clubs spread quickly. Later activities included pipe and drum bands.

These days, young people, girls and boys especially in the formative years 10-16 need adults around them to serve as positive role models who support and encourage them. PCYC gets young people physically active and develops skills, character and leadership. PCYC Far South Coast is a partnership between the Eurobodalla Shire Council, Bega Valley Shire Council, NSW Police and NSW PCYC. A committee has been set up and plans underway for programs and activities to be offered at the Leisure Centre, PCYC's base in Narooma. Members include Gary as CEO, the Aboriginal Community Liaison officer, Police case workers, and Council's Youth & Recreation Manager and Kim Bush, Social Inclusion Manager.

Today there are 57 PCYC clubs in NSW with 80,000 members with a wide range of sporting activities. Gary finds many parallels with Youth Programs run by Rotary and as PCYC is a not for profit organisation looks forward to working with us in the future on some joint fundraising activities like a breakfast BBQ for local golf events.
